Instructions: This assignment consists of two parts. Part I consists of ten logical questions. Part II consists of ten MC questions. You have to answer all of them. Put your answers in a MS WORD file, or other word processing file, and then submit the file to the course Gmail account.

PART I: Logical Questions

The questions in the part are logical questions. In each question, two statements \mathbf{X} and \mathbf{Y} are given. You need to select one of the following options for your answer.

- (a) Both statements **X** and **Y** are not true.
- (b) Statement **X** is true. Statement **Y** is not true.
- (c) Statement X is not true. Statement Y is true.
- (d) Both statements \mathbf{X} and \mathbf{Y} are true. But statements \mathbf{X} and \mathbf{Y} do not have any logical implication.
- (e) Both statements X and Y are true. Statement X is a cause of statement Y but not in reverse.
- (f) Both statements X and Y are true. StatementY is a cause of statement X but not in reverse.

Question 1

X: There was no electronic computer in 400 years ago.

Y: There was no accounting information system in 400 years ago.

Answer: B.

Question 2

X: In the World War II, Alan Turing and his team designed an electronic computer and applied it to break the secret code hidden in the messages communicated within the German armies.

Y: UK made the world first commercial computer in the history.

Answer: D.

Question 3

X: Vacuum tube was invented earlier than the first generation electronic computers.

Y: Vacuum tube was a key component in the first generation electronic computers.

Answer: E.

Question 4

X: A cell phone can connect to the Internet via WiFi only.

Y: A notebook computer can connect to the Internet via WiFi only.

Question 5

X: The first public demonstration of a mouse-control computer was in 1960s.

Y: In 1984, Apple released the Mackintosh which had embedded with a computer graphical interface for controlling the operating system.
