2 Project Report Presentation

Progress report presentations are scheduled on Lecture 8 and Lecture 9. The final report presentations are scheduled on Lecture 15 and Lecture 16. If necessary, additional lecture will be arranged.

2.1 Submissions

For both progress report and final report, you need to submit to me (1) *an electronic file of your written report* and (2) *an electronic file of your set of presentation slides* for assessment. Moreover, you need to give an oral presentation during the progress (resp. final) report weeks.

2.2 Attendance

As progress reporting and final reporting are treated as the mid-term exam and final exam, students must be present in these four lectures and attend all presentations. Each student has to ready both written progress (resp. final) report and presentation slides before progress (resp. final) reporting.

2.3 Presentation Sequence

The sequence of presentations will usually be arranged in random order. Under exception situation with supporting document proof, a student can request for special arrangement.

2.4 Presentation Duration

Each student has 20-25 minutes for his/her oral presentation, together with questions and answers. Thus, six to eight presentations can be complete in a reporting session and all presentation can be finished by two lecture weeks.
